1-15-21

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 67 residents and 40 staff members test positive for COVID-19. In the past week, we have no additional staff or residents test positive. On 1-2-21, we tested 91 staff. All were negative. On 1-11-21, we tested 28 residents and all were negative. On 1-12-21, we tested 85 staff and all were negative.

The facility had its second vaccination clinic scheduled for 1-13-21. We vaccinated several staff and residents. Our third and final clinic is scheduled for 2-3-21.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

Please continue to check our website for weekly updates as well as notification of new cases. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 67 residents and 40 staff members test positive for COVID-19. On 1-15-21, 79 staff were tested and all were negative. On 1-18-21, 36 residents were tested, and all were negative. On 1-19-21, 80 staff were tested and all were negative. We will continue to test staff twice a week. We will test all residents as needed.

At this time, we are still not permitting visitors, but monitoring the county positivity rate closely. When it reaches under 10%, we will start permitting visitors.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 67 residents and 40 staff members test positive for COVID-19. On 1-22-21, we tested 86 staff members, all were negative. On 1-26-21, we tested 82 staff, and all were negative. We did not have to test all the residents this week.

The county positivity rate remains over 10%, so unfortunately, we are not permitting visitors, but we hope to open up soon.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 67 residents and 40 staff members test positive for COVID-19. On 12-30-20, we tested staff and all were negative. On 1-4-21, we tested 26 residents, all were negative. On 1-5-21, we tested 83 staff, one was positive. This person's last day worked was 12-17-20, and was asymptomatic. A PCR test was sent for confirmation.

The facility has its second vaccination clinic scheduled for 1-13-21.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering.
