

## **WEEKLY UPDATE**

**11-14-20**

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 12 residents and 9 staff members test positive for COVID-19. On 11-6-20, 111 staff were tested and one was positive, 110 were negative. This positive individual was reported on last week's update. We tested all in house residents on 11-7-20, Of the 119 residents tested, one as positive. 118 were negative. On 11-10-20, 118 staff were tested, all were negative. On Thursday, 11-12-20, two residents became symptomatic and were tested. Both were positive. The facility retested the residents on the hallway on 11-13-20. On 11-13-20, 20 residents were tested, and two additional were positive. The facility currently has a total of five positive residents in house. They were all moved to our Covid unit and we are monitoring their vital signs and their symptoms. All the staff were tested again on 11-13-20, those results are pending and will be reported in next week's update.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

Please continue to check our website for weekly updates as well as notification of new cases. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.

## **WEEKLY UPDATE AND NOTIFICATION OF NEW CASES**

**November 18, 2020**

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 18 residents and 14 staff members test positive for COVID-19. This week, we had an additional five staff members and three residents test positive. On Friday 11-13-20, 114 staff were tested and all were negative. On 11-16-20, four residents were tested, and all four were negative. On 11-17-20, 115 staff were tested, and five were positive. Four residents were tested, and one was positive. On 11-18-20, two residents were tested, and both were positive. Currently, the facility has seven residents on their COVID unit. All in house residents will be tested again on 11-19-20. All staff will be tested again on 11-20-20.

While we are disappointed that we are seeing additional cases in our facility, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 7 residents and 9 staff members test positive for COVID-19. On Friday, 10-30-20, 116 staff members were tested, and all were negative. On Tuesday, 11-3-20, 113 staff members were tested and one was positive. Since a staff member tested positive, we tested all our residents. On Wednesday, 11-4-20, 114 residents were tested and all were negative. We tested again on 11-6-20, and one came back positive, the others are still pending, and the total numbers will be reported on next week's update.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC.
