## WEEKLY UPDATE

**12-11-20**

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 60 residents and 32 staff members test positive for COVID-19. On Friday, on 12-4-20, the facility tested 101 staff members and all were negative. On 12-8-20, 101 employees were tested, and two were positive. This was previously reported this week on our website. On 12-9-20, 49 residents were tested, and 13 were positive. On 12-11-20, two additional residents tested positive. On 12-11-20, five staff members recovered and are able to return to work.

As you have probably heard, the CDC recently announced that healthcare workers and long-term care residents would be among the first group of people to receive the vaccine for COVID-19. We are optimistic this will help stop the spread of this virus in our community. Consents for the vaccines are currently available and while we do not have the exact dates that the vaccines will be administered, we will let you know as soon as that information is available. In the meantime, please continue to do your part in limiting the transmission of COVID-19 by wearing masks, washing your hands and keeping a safe distance from others.

We are also working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

Please continue to check our website for weekly updates as well as notification of new cases. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 45 residents and 27 staff members test positive for COVID-19. We are happy to report that 17 residents have recovered and transferred out of the COVID unit. Five staff members have resolved, with two more expected to return to work today.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

## WEEKLY UPDATE

**12-30-20**

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 67 residents and 39 staff members test positive for COVID-19. On 12-21-20, we tested 74 staff and one was positive. On 12-23-20, we tested 76 staff and one was positive. On 12-23-20, we tested 28 residents and all were negative. On 12-28-20, we tested 74 staff and all were negative. On 12-29-20, we tested 28 residents, and two were positive. On 12-23-20, approximately 70 staff and 40 residents received the first dose of the Pfizer COVID vaccine. Our second clinic is scheduled for 1-13-20.

At this time, there are no changes to visitation. We are not permitting visitors at this time, due to high county positivity rates, but we are reviewing weekly, and will open to visitors as soon as we are able.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.
