WEEKLY UPDATE

3-18-21

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 67 residents and 40 staff members test positive for COVID-19. On 3-12-21, 104 staff were tested and all were negative. On 3-16-21, 100 staff were tested and all were negative. Effective next week, we will be decreasing our testing frequency down to once per week.

We are happy to report that we will be opening up to visitation as early as next week. We are in the process of developing the plan to ensure visitation is conducted safely. Once we have completed the plan, you will be notified by mail, as well as on the website.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.
