Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 7 residents and 5 staff members test positive for COVID-19. We are happy to report, that a total of four residents have resolved and moved on to our step-down unit, and one employee has returned to work. We only have two positive patients on our Covid unit, and one is asymptomatic, the other one is improving.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

Please continue to check our website for weekly updates as well as notification of new cases. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.

## WEEKLY UPDATE

**August 21, 2020**

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 7 residents and 6 staff members test positive for COVID-19. We are happy to report that all of our COVID positive residents are now considered recovered! One additional staff member was positive this week, but she has not worked since August 8, 2020 and has minimal symptoms. The most recent staff members have recovered also. The two staff members that tested positive early on (one in March and one in April) have not returned. With the exception of the newly positive last week, the remainder of the staff have recovered and returned to work.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC.
